

Announcing the New CYS President's Cup

Beginning Fall of 2009 CYS will present the Colorado Presidents Cup competition as part of U.S. Youth Soccer's National Presidents Cup. Established by U.S. Youth Soccer to offer more soccer excitement and more equitable competition for "non-elite" youth soccer teams, Colorado's Presidents Cup will be open to all **P2 and lower division** boys and girls teams ages U-13 through U-17.

Colorado Presidents Cup games will be structured much the same as Colorado State Cup, and will run parallel to State Cup matches. For U-13 thru U-17 age groups, Colorado Presidents Cup will advance state champions in each gender/age group to a Region IV Presidents Cup Championship in June of 2010 in Oregon.

Regional winners in the U-14 thru U-17 divisions will advance to a National Presidents Cup Championship in July of 2010 (site TBA). Currently, there is no National Presidents Cup opportunity for U-13's.

By entering the Presidents Cup in Colorado, all eligible teams agree to travel to represent Colorado at the Regional Presidents Cup Championships, and if successful there, also agree to travel to the National Presidents Cup event as the age group representative for Region IV.

Both State Cup and Presidents Cup are open to all duly registered age appropriate CYS teams. Please Note: These events are mutually exclusive. **Teams who enter the Presidents Cup may not play in State Cup, and vice versa.**
